### **Coronation Anthem No. 1, Zadok the Priest**

George Frideric Handel (1685-1759)

Zadok, the Priest, and Nathan, the Prophet, anointed Solomon King;  
And all the people rejoiced, and said:  
God save the King, long live the King, God save the King!  
May the King live forever! Amen, Alleluia!

### **Magnificat**

Giovanni Battista Pergolesi (1710-1736)

1. Magnificat (Chorus)

My soul doth magnify the Lord, and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. For He hath regarded the low estate of His handmaiden: for behold, from hence forth all generations shall call me blessed. For He that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is His name.

2. Et misericordia (Solos and Chorus)

And His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation. He has shown strength with His arm; He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

3. Deposuit (Chorus)

He has put down the mighty from their thrones, and exalted those of low degree. He has filled the hungry with good things; and the rich He has sent empty away.

4. Suscepit Israel (Duet)

He has helped His servant Israel, in remembrance of His mercy.

5. Sicut locutus est (Chorus)

As He spoke to our fathers, to Abraham and to His posterity forever. Glory be to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

6. Sicut erat in principio (Chorus)

As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

## **Organ Concerto in B flat, Op. 4, No. 2**

George Frideric Handel

### **Te Deum**

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791)

O God, we praise Thee: we acknowledge Thee to be the Lord. Everlasting Father, all the earth doth worship Thee. To Thee all the angels, the heavens and all the powers, all the cherubim and seraphim unceasingly proclaim: Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Hosts! Heaven and earth are full of the Majesty of Thy glory.

The glorious choir of the apostles, the wonderful company of prophets, the white-robed army of Martyrs, praise Thee. Holy Church throughout the world doth acknowledge Thee: the Father of infinite Majesty; Thy adorable, true and only Son; and the Holy Spirit, the Comforter.

O Christ, Thou art the King of glory! Thou art the everlasting Son of the Father. Thou, having taken it upon thyself to deliver man, didst not disdain the Virgin's womb. Thou overcame the sting of death and hast opened to believers the King of Heaven. Thou sittest [sic] at the right hand of God, in the glory of the Father. We believe that Thou shalt come to be our Judge.

We beseech Thee, therefore, to help Thy servants whom Thou has redeemed with Thy precious blood.

Make them to be numbered with Thy saints in everlasting glory. Save Thy people, O Lord, and bless Thine inheritance! Govern them, and raise them up forever. Every day we thank Thee. And we praise Thy name forever, yea, forever and ever. O Lord, deign to keep us from sin this day.

Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy on us.

Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us, for we have hoped in Thee.

O Lord, in Thee i have hoped; let me never be put to shame.
